

## Short Hiking Tours in MondSeeLand

### **Helenenweg:** (about half an hour one way)

You start in the center of Mondsee, walk past the cemetery, turn right at Steininger's flowershop.

Follow the river Zeller Ache. You will reach the company ABW, turn right and walk between the two factory buildings, indicated by the yellow marker. You'll reach the Helenenweg, the path along the river. Don't turn right but follow the path until you reach the little bridge, cross it and you soon will see Gasthof Erlachmühle.

If you don't want to go back the same way, turn left beyond Erlachmühle and follow the road turning south. You'll see the yellow signs on your right leading up the path through the meadow to Gasthof Leidinger – Kolomansberg. You can follow it to enjoy the marvellous view from the upper road. You could also walk on the road. You'll soon see the yellow sign leading back to Mondsee.

### **Irrsee-Wildenegg:** (about two hours)

You start at the Gasthof Fischhof and walk south along the small road. You will pass nice houses and a farmhouse called Wildenegg. About 500 m after the farmhouse Wildenegg the yellow signs on your right show you the way to Ruine Wildenegg. The path leads you through the meadow and the woods steeply uphill. From Wildenegg you continue on the little path uphill until you reach a forest road. Turn right and follow the road for about 500 m. Don't miss the yellow sign on your right leading you back to Gasthof Fischhof. Enjoy the breathtaking view of lake Irrsee and the mountain scenery near the farmhouses.

**Tannenweg:** (about three hours)

You start at the Mondseeberg. Drive up to the vista point (Aussichtsparkplatz II) and enjoy the view of Mondsee and the marvellous surrounding.

Drive on to the bus-stop on your left. Nearby you park your car. Beyond the bus-stop on the left you see the fir-tree-sign. You'll find it along the whole way. You pass the farmhouses of Ebnat, then the path leads across the meadow, through the woods and to the small river Vöckla. Turn left along the Vöckla until you reach the little road. Follow it through to Harpoint, continuing to the Lindenbauernkapelle. Here you have a nice view of Irrsee and Sommerholz. From there you follow the signs through Lindau and Sulzberg back to the bus-stop near Hochmoor where you had parked your car.

**Kirchenweg:** (about five hours)

The circular trail starts at Jausenstation Erlachmühle. Beyond Erlachmühle you follow the road turning south. You'll see the yellow signs on your right leading up the path through the meadow to Gasthof Leidinger – Kolomansberg. Enjoy the marvellous view from the upper road. Walking on the road you pass Panoramagasthof Leidingerhof. Right after this inn you pass a few houses and follow the path through the meadow to a bench, next to a wayside shrine, from where you have a marvellous view. Soon the path leads through the woods and steeply up the mountain. After about 1 ½ hours walk you arrive at the Kolomansberg. There you see the wooden church of St. Koloman, the oldest wooden church in Austria. Beyond this point is "off limits" because of a military installation.

On the way down behind the church you pass the spring Kolomansbründl. The yellow signs show you the way to Kolomanstaferl. This trail is rather steep and also the one to the inn Hochsernerhof.

From there you follow the road to Haidermühle and along the river Zeller Ache back to Erlachmühle.

**Konradweg:** (about three hours)

Take the bus to the village center of Oberwang.

Yellow signs show you the way to the Konradkirche. If you want to visit the church ask for the key at the house next door.

The Konradweg leads through the woods. After about 15 minutes you'll reach Konradkapelle and Konradspring (no drinking water!)

Follow the yellow signs (route no. 21 and also the pilgrims' way VIA NOVA). You walk through meadows and woods, along roads – always a nice view of Mondsee and the lake. Then you pass under the motorway and reach the famous pilgrim church Maria Hilf. Walk down the hill to the basilica of Mondsee. There the relic of St. Konrad is exhibited on the main altar.
