Project 1

Working title: “One day and night in a suburb”

Hosts/hostesses, families and individuals living in this neighbourhood will invite guests to spend an afternoon + evening + morning in their home and the part of town immediately surrounding it. The aim of this project is to cultivate hospitality, to get people communicating with one another, and to achieve sustainability on the part of both hosts and guests. In addition to emphasizing the many possible forms that hospitality can take, this project also sets great store in highlighting our neighbourhood's outstanding features: wonderful sports and recreational facilities, architectural gems, historical curiosities and much more. This project's target audience includes everyone living in this part of town who would like to serve as host/hostess and all those who would like to get better acquainted with this tiny part of the world we live in.

Project 2

Working title: “Homepage for the Kleinmünchen Neighborhood”
