Working title: “Völkergarten” (Garden of the Peoples)

The name of our neighbourhood park “*Volksgarten*” (Garden of the People) will be changed to “*Völkergarten*” (Garden of the Peoples) for a month. Renaming it is meant to establish a connective element in Neustadtviertel, a part of town whose population includes many different ethnic groups.

Under the aegis of this new name, the project organizers will conduct a cultural and athletic confrontation with the theme of “the people and the peoples.”

There will also be culinary offerings featuring specialties from the distinctive cuisines of many different ethnic groups. Planting an international garden is also planned. The networking that goes into this project is designed to be as broad-based as possible and include participation by a wide array of interested groups, organizations, associations and initiatives.
